Autism workshops resume Thursday

Expert will offer parents, teachers ways to address difficult behavior

LA VERNE — Speech pathologist Lisa Bradshaw will continue a three-month series on sensory processing and behavioral management to assist children with autism.

The free parenting workshops are at the School for Autism at LeRoy Haynes Center, 233 W. Base Line Road.

The workshops, scheduled for 6 to 8 p.m. Thursday and May

26, are designed for parents and teachers of children who have or may have autism.

Bradshaw will focus on behavior management, sensory processing, and behavioral and sensory techniques to address difficult behaviors.

The discussion also will take a look at activities such as deep-pressure brushing and music therapy.
