

PREPARATION FOR YOUR INTERVIEW

References-bring a list of 3 references; do not use family members

Portfolio- prepare a sample of documents, projects and pictures representing your skills and achievements in a notebook or portfolio binder

Know your employer-learn about the company

Be prepared to emphasize your strengths and how they fit the job

Dress up-first impressions are lasting

Bring several copies of your resume, a pad of paper and pen to make notes, and your personal identification documents (social security card, driver's license)

Arrive early and call if you are delayed or need to reschedule
